I am doing well here. I actually like this jail better than some of the others I have been to, not to say that I am fond of being back. Chances are, I will receive 18 months here. Once I finish my time in MA, I'll be on my way back to New Hampshire State Prison until Nov. 7 2013, or 2012 depending on how NH is doing "good time". My parole officer does not want me out until I max my original sentence.

I would love a copy of 'Healing Our World', but for me to get it at this jail or the prison in NH, it would have to be sent from a store such as Border's. If a copy does end up this way, you have my word that it will be shared around and put in the library for future inmates to find.

I am glad that 420 and the nightcup are still strong. I have been somewhat worried because they were starting to fade over the last few weeks. And if you would, every now and then at the celebration's, remind people that I gave up the few freedoms I had for the next few years over a victimless crime. Even though it wasn't C.D., I knew what could possibly happen and refused to follow the orders from a government that already took what was rightfully mine. I just want people to know that when I stood, and continue to stand, beside them to fight for freedom and liberty, I knew my spot was different because of parole and risked a lot, even if it didn't seem it ~~at~~ at the time.
