ORDER

The Court conducted a review hearing this date with respect to Mr. Johnson's payment of his Court Ordered fine. Mr. Johnson provided the Court with a financial affidavit reflecting the fact that he was the owner of unencumbered real estate in Winchester, NH, that he values at \$89,000.00. The Court inquired of Mr. Johnson whether he had any proposals for the payment of this fine if he were released, to which he responded that it was against his morals to pay the fine, and that he had no intention to do so. This Court lacks the statutory authority to have stand committed time or community service satisfy Mr. Johnson's fine. Mr. Johnson was therefore returned to the Cheshire County House of Corrections, as he continues to be in contempt.
