ORDER ON MOTION TO DISMISS

Because the Court is not persuaded that the state's alleged failure to provide witness information in timely fashion has prejudiced the defendant, the Court is not inclined to dismiss the case. The Court will, however, give the defendant the benefit of the doubt and continue the trial if the defendant requests it. That request must be made, in writing, by Monday, April 16, 2012, at Noon.

Since the companion cases of State v. Horton and State v. Sieradzki were, in the interest of judicial economy, in all likelihood going to be consolidated with the defendant's, those cases will also be continued on the Court's own motion if Mr. Freeman's case is continued. Otherwise, all three mattes will go on as scheduled on April 17, 2012.
