STATE'S OBJECTION TO DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through Trooper Kelly Healey, New Hampshire State Police, who hereby Objects to the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss-Right to Speedy Trial and in support thereof states the following:

1. The Defendant was charged with Speeding, a Violation, on November 5, 2011.
2. The Defendant has filed a Motion to Dismiss stating that his right to a speedy trial has been violated.
3. The State objects to the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss-Right to a Speedy Trial.
4. The Defendant was given a pre-trial conference date of September 25, 2012.
5. A pre-trial conference is scheduled by the Court to allow the Defendant to try and mediate his case. If the Defendant does not want a pre-trial he may request a trial date.
6. On May 9, 2012 the Defendant filed a motion to cancel the September 25, 2012 pre-trial conference.
7. On May 27, 2012 the Court (Patten, J) granted the Defendant's motion. The Court scheduled the trial for January 10, 2013.
8. The State did not violate the Defendant's right to a speedy trial as the hearings were scheduled based on the Court's procedure and their availability to schedule hearings.

WHEREFORE, the State prays that this Honorable Court:

- A. Deny the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss-Right to Speedy Trial; and
- B. Grant any other and further relief the court deems just.


