**State of New Hampshire v. A. Marple**

**ORDER**

A trial in the above captioned case was held on April 18, 2017, on the charges of Driving after Suspension and Driver's License Prohibitions.

Although the Court urged Mr. Marple to actively participate in the trial, he declined to do so because of his continued belief that this Court does not have the authority or jurisdiction to hear these matters.


At the conclusion of the trial, the Court took the matters under advisement. Now, after carefully considering the testimony and evidence presented the Court rules as follows:

On the charge of Driver's License Prohibitions, the Court finds Mr. Marple **Not Guilty**. Although the Court finds the Officer's testimony that he requested a driver's license from Mr. Marple, and Mr. Marple produced one, completely credible, neither the actual driver's license nor a copy was submitted into evidence, which the Court believes would have been necessary in order for the State to reach their beyond a reasonable doubt burden of proof.

As to the charge of Driving after Suspension, the Court finds Mr. Marple **Guilty**. A fine of \$250.00 plus a \$60.00 penalty assessment is imposed. However, the fine and penalty assessment are suspended for a period of six months conditioned upon Mr. Marple having no other moving motor vehicle violation offenses within that time period.
