(1) Nine states, including all three states neighboring New Hampshire, have passed laws making cannabis possession legal for use by adults. Do you support making it legal for adults 21 and older to possess marijuana in New Hampshire?

Comment: *I support it being legal for anyone to possess, grow, distribute, use, or sell cannabis.*

(2) Massachusetts, Maine, and six other states have passed laws regulating and taxing the production and retail sale of cannabis for use by adults. A study commission is currently contemplating this issue in New Hampshire, and it is expected to make specific recommendations in November regarding how (not whether) the state should do so. Do you support regulating and taxing cannabis for retail sale to adults 21 and older?

Comment: *I support ending prohibitions, not regulating and taxing, which continues giving the state control over a harmless plant.*

(3) All three neighboring states allow adults 21 and older to cultivate their own limited supply of cannabis for personal use. Do you support allowing adults to grow their own cannabis for personal use in New Hampshire?
