OBJECTION TO APPEARANCE AND RULE 1.3(D)
STATEMENT FILED BY BRADLEY JARDIS


1. Now comes the State by its Prosecutor and objects to the Appearance filed by Bradley Juris in the above criminal case.
2. Mr. Jardis is not a member of the New Hampshire Bar and he has not filed a Pro Hac Vice application.
3. The New Hampshire Rules of Criminal Procedure **Rule 42** requires any persons representing a defendant in a criminal proceeding to be admitted to the Bar in this State or apply for Pro Hac Vice.

WHEREFORE the State respectfully requests the Honorable Court:

- A. Deny Bradley Jardis request to appear on behalf of Joseph Hart because that rule only applies to civil proceedings.
- B. Issue a ruling that Mr. Hardis is not permitted to file an appearance as counsel for Mr. Hart in a criminal proceeding because NHRCP 42 requires counsel of record to be admitted to the NH Bar, or apply as Pro Hac Vice.
- C. Order such other relief as justice may require.
