

The court does not agree with the State's argument that Dist. Div. Rule 1.3D is only applicable to civil cases. Criminal Procedure Rule 42 must be read in conjunction with Dist. Div. Rule 1.3D, which specifically references appearances of non-lawyers in any actions, not just civil actions.

However, prior to approving the appearance of Mr. Jardis, the court requires him to supplement his submitted statement, as the court form does not include two of the attestations required by Rule 1.3D. Specifically, Mr. Jardis shall file a statement reflecting his answers to parts (d) and (e) of Rule 1.3D, as cited below:

- (d) all prior proceedings in which said person has not been permitted to appear, plead, prosecute or defend any action for any party, other than himself or herself, in any court, and
- (e) all prior proceedings in which said person's permission to appear, plead, prosecute or defend any action for any party, other than himself or herself, in any court has been revoked.
