**CERTIFICATE PURSUANT TO RSA 613:3-a TO SUMMONS WITNESS LOCATED
OUTSIDE THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

I, Anne M. Edwards., a Judge of Superior Court of the State of New Hampshire, in and for the County of CHESHIRE, a Court of record, do hereby certify:

This matter has come for a hearing on a petition, by the State of New Hampshire, requesting that a certificate be issued pursuant to the Uniform Act, to Secure Witnesses from without State in Criminal proceedings. See and N.H. R.S.A. 613:3-a The State of New Hampshire seeks to obtain the testimony and material records in the possession of Bradley Jardis who resides at 10 Congress Street #302, Amesbury, MA 01913.

1. A further Hearing is scheduled for October 14, 2025 on the States Motion to Show Cause as to why Robert LaMontagne should not be found in contempt of court for unauthorized disclosure of sealed pleadings and material.
2. That witness Bradley Jardis is a necessary and material witness for the State of New Hampshire in said prosecution; without said testimony and material records, said hearing of this crime cannot proceed. Accordingly, the State is issuing a subpoena to secure said witness's testimony and records in the custody of the witness. A copy of the subpoena is attached here to.
3. That if said witness comes into the State of New Hampshire under an Order issued in reliance on this Certificate directing the witness to testify at said hearing, the State of New Hampshire and any other state through which said witness may be required to pass by the ordinary course of travel to attend said hearing, give the witness protection from the arrest or service of process, civil or criminal, in connection with the matters which arose before the witness's entrance into said state pursuant to said order;
4. That the said witness will be tendered travel expenses for each day the witness is required to travel and attend as a witness on October 14, 2025 at 2:30 PM. In addition, I will order the payment of witness fees authorized by law for each day the witness is required to attend the Court, plus reimbursement for any additional expenses of the witness which I shall find reasonable and necessary.
5. That this Certificate is made for the purpose of being presented to a Justice of the Peace where said witness is residing, to compel said witness to attend and testify at the hearing in said criminal prosecution before this Court in the State of New Hampshire as a material witness.


6. The State of New Hampshire has, by its laws, made provision to summons witnesses within its borders to testify in other states, including Massachusetts See N.H. RSA 613:3;

**EX PARTE PETITION FOR ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE PURSUANT TO RSA 613 TO
SUMMONS A WITNESS, BRADLEY JARDIS LOCATED OUTSIDE
THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through its attorneys, the Office of Grafton County Attorney and respectfully requests this Honorable Court to issue a certificate pursuant to N.H. RSA 613, to summons a witness located outside the State of New Hampshire. In support of its Motion, the State declares as follows:

1. A further Hearing is scheduled for October 14, 2025 on the State's Motion to Show Cause as to why Robert LaMontagne should not be found in contempt of court for unauthorized disclosure of sealed pleadings and material.
2. The State has found that certain testimony of Bradley Jardis is necessary to its prosecution. Accordingly, the Office of the Grafton County Attorney has issued a subpoena to secure the attendance of the material witness. A copy of the subpoena is attached. Under the provisions of the Uniform Act to Secure the Attendance of Witnesses from Without a State in Criminal Proceedings, the State of Massachusetts is authorized to enforce a subpoena issued in New Hampshire.

WHEREFORE, the State of New Hampshire respectfully prays the Honorable Court to:

- A. Issue a certification pursuant to R.S.A. 613 to require Bradley Jardis to be present at CHESHIRE County Superior Court beginning October 14, 2025 at 2:30 PM in regard to the above matter.
- A. Grant such other and further relief as the Honorable Court deems necessary and just.







AFFIDAVIT

I, Martha Hornick, Esq., being duly sworn, do hereby depose and say:

1. I am the Grafton County Attorney and I represent the State of New Hampshire in the above-captioned matter.
2. This matter involves and is scheduled for a hearing on the State of New Hampshire's motion requesting that the Court order the defendant to appear and show cause as to why he should not be found in contempt of court for unauthorized disclosure of sealed pleadings and materials. Bradley Jardis is a material and necessary witness for the State at the hearing.
3. On May 4, 2025, LaMontagne mailed for filing in the above-captioned matter a Petition for Writ of Mandamus. Soon after, Mr. Jardis filed an appearance in the matter as a non-attorney to represent LaMontagne in the litigation of the Petition. On June 5, 2025, the State filed an Objection to the defendant's Petition for Writ of Mandamus. Due to the Objection's reference of a previously sealed motion and order, the State filed its Objection as a non-public document and simultaneously filed a Motion to Seal the same, also filed as a non-public document. On June 6, 2025, the Court granted the State's Motion to Seal the State's Objection to the defendant's Petition for Writ of Mandamus.
4. On or about June 7, 2025, I was informed by Mr. Jardis that Mr. LaMontagne allegedly shared the sealed objection with unauthorized individuals, despite Mr. Jardis' warning him not to share the same. As a result of Mr. LaMontagne's actions, Mr. Jardis informed the State that he planned to withdraw as the defendant's representative in this matter. Mr. Jardis has since withdrawn as Mr. LaMontagne's non-attorney representative.
5. The State plans to call Mr. Jardis as a witness at the hearing to testify to the warning that he provided to Mr. LaMontagne concerning the sealed nature of the relevant pleadings, along with the facts surrounding his belief that Mr. LaMontagne improperly shared the sealed pleading(s).
6. That Bradley Jardis is a resident of the state of Massachusetts.


